Looking forward to IAAF World Athletics Day 2015

Now in its 20th year, **IAAF World Athletics Day** is the sport's annual worldwide festival of youth and one of the busiest programmes of competitions on the athletics calendar.

With 118 member federations already signed up to take part, World Athletics Day offers the opportunity to promote the sport through youth participation in clubs and schools.

IAAF World Athletics Day 2015 will take place in May, preferably the weekend of 9-10 May, and will involve youth age group children from clubs who were born in 1998-1999 (16-17 years old).

Cali 2015 set to be biggest ever athletics competition in South America

Preliminary entry figures show that 1424 athletes from 156 countries are set to compete at the IAAF World Youth Championships, Cali 2015, making it the biggest international athletics event to be held in South America.

Svein Arne Hansen elected President of European Athletics

Svein Arne Hansen of Norway was elected as President of European Athletics. Hansen received 26 votes from the 50 European Athletics member federations, giving him an overall majority in the first round of voting.
