Looking forward to the IAAF World Race Walking Team Championships Taicang 2018 and IAAF Diamond League

The first two World Athletics Series events of 2018 were held last month and it is already time for a third.

The **IAAF World Race Walking Team Championships Taicang 2018** on 5-6 May will bring together the world's best race walkers to compete for both individual and team honours. With more than 300 athletes set to take part, this competition is the biggest gathering of race walkers outside of the major track and field championships.

Next month also marks the start of the IAAF Diamond League.

The sport's premier circuit of one-day competitions returns on 4 May in Doha for its ninth season. And in a year with no senior outdoor global championships, the IAAF Diamond League will take on even more significance in 2018 as athletes compete for the honour of being the world No.1 in their event.

The IAAF World Challenge, IAAF Combined Events Challenge and IAAF Hammer Throw Challenge all get underway in the next few weeks, signalling the start of a busy summer season.
