Looking forward to the IAAF World U20 Championships Tampere 2018

The world's best young athletes will soon be heading to Finland for the **IAAF World U20 Championships Tampere 2018**, which will take place from 10-15 July.

About 1500 athletes from more than 150 teams are expected to be in Tampere as Finland hosts its first ever global age-group athletics championships.

"With 49 Olympic track and field champions to date, Finland punches above its weight in athletics," said IAAF President Sebastian Coe. "The country is arguably the modern spiritual home of athletics.

"The combination of an unrivalled national athletics culture, vast hosting experience and an athletics-loving city will ensure that the IAAF World U20 Championships Tampere 2018 will be an athletics meeting to savour."
