#### Why I am running for the election:

Therefore the importance of women's health and sports gynaecology in (elite) sports is something that deserves its voice. I strongly believe this voice should come from an athlete and a woman.

Coming from a small country, Slovenia, without a tradition of a higher rank of international competitions at home, I experience a difference in opportunities to equally compete and collect world ranking points. I will strongly advocate for equal opportunities for all athletes, regardless of the country of their origin, to compete and collect world ranking points to qualify for World championships, Olympic games, Area championships, etc.

As a young athlete I understand the struggle of the transition from the junior to the senior category and the importance of different kinds of support during this period. I myself come from an athletic family, who understand my love and devotion to athletics, and provide support in difficult times. Unfortunately, I regularly notice that other talented athletes have less of this support in their environment, and I believe that adequate support outside of their primary environment is necessary and should be properly organised.

In conclusion, I'm fully committed to safety in sport aiming to educate and protect athletes from harassment and abuse of all forms. I am ready to dedicate my energy to raise awareness among groups that need special attention like youth, girls, women and other vulnerable athletes.
