With the IAAF indoor track and cross country permit seasons concluded, the sport now enters a concentrated period in the calendars of the <u>IAAF</u> <u>Road Race Label</u> events and <u>IAAF Race Walking Challenge</u>.

There are twelve IAAF Label Races in the month of April alone, as the spring road running season in the northern hemisphere really kicks off. The IAAF Race Walking Challenge also gets into full swing, as following on from three Area permit races whose results count for the final standings, and the first IAAF Permit event in Chihuahua, Mexico, in the last two months, we keenly anticipate two more IAAF competitions in Taicang (CHN), 30 March, and Rio Maior (POR), 14 April, which lead into <u>IAAF World Race Walking Cup</u>, <u>Saransk</u>, <u>2012</u> on the weekend of 12/13 May.

Please note that the athlete, Ramon CLAY (USA), was incorrectly published in the March edition of the IAAF Newsletter on 27 March 2012 as serving a 2year suspension from 1.3.11 – 28.2.13 for a Doping Offence (Violation of the Prohibition during Ineligibility). The IAAF wishes to make clear that Mr Clay has not been found guilty of such a Doping Offence and is not currently serving any form of suspension from competition, either provisional or otherwise.
