Looking ahead to... Moscow 2013, the world's largest global sports event of the year

The 2013 edition of the biennial [IAAF World Championships](#) will take place in **Moscow, Russia** from Saturday 10 to Sunday 18 August, and will be preceded by the **49th IAAF Congress**, Wednesday 7 to Thursday 8 August, in the capital of the Russian Federation. The IAAF Council will also gather in Moscow and as is traditional on the occasion of the IAAF World Championships will hold a joint meeting with the Board of the International Olympic Committee.

This year marks 30 years since the first IAAF World Championships were held in Helsinki, just three years after Moscow hosted the 1980 Olympic Games. In three decades, we have seen the IAAF's premier championships grow from an event with 1355 athletes from 153 nations to one with more than 2000 athletes representing more than 200 countries and territories, making it the biggest single-sport event in the world bar the FIFA World Cup. The 14th edition of the championships will be the largest global sporting event of the year, the nine days of action reaching more than five billion TV viewers in more than 200 territories across the globe.

Concluding a packed fortnight of activities the **2nd IAAF World Coaches' Conference** will be staged on Monday 19 August.
